The I Want person almost always has a controlling personality.


If both parties only pursue their own interests, there has to be a winner and a loser.

And, that is not good for decision making.






Let's add another position. They want.

A Leader is not going to prioritize their wants or the wants of those around them.


A Leader may not always make the popular decision, but they will always try to make the <u>right</u> decision based on what is **needed**.




Making decisions with selfish people almost always leads to conflict.
